### Wye River Bushfire Planning Session

November 7 presentation at Wye River Surf Club attended by 70 people. Overwhelmingly positive response & over 40 attendees gave contact details for continuing involvement.

The planning session had 3 elements:

- Fire scenario using the Phoenix Rapid Fire modeling tool, assuming the fire started at Mount Sabine, travelled South to the coast and East towards Lorne
- Local history of fires & risk factors
- Options available to reduce risk
